- Assist with the preparation of project reporting, budgets and forecasts to meet RDT's company objectives and budget
- Assist with the estimation of new projects and or change requests
- Assist with stakeholder engagement directly with the customer assisting them write user stories and acceptance criteria to the level of granularity required by the team, in collaboration with the team
- Remove business related impediments raised by the team
- Assist in preparation of acceptance tests from acceptance criteria
- Provide regular feedback on testing deliverables against user story acceptance criteria
- Provide regular feedback by validating that the product meets RDT company objectives and meets customer's needs
- Accepting or reject each story based on definition of done
- Peer review the output of other company functions as part of RDT's quality assurance processes e.g. training material, system documentation etc.
- Participate in RDT's product development process from idea generation, screening, idea evaluation, development through to commercialisation

- Clear concise timely written & verbal communication with ability to conduct meetings hold workshops, presentations and demonstrate active listening
- Open and transparent in giving and receiving information and does not hide from difficult conversations
- Actively work with other Product Owners and Business Analysts to maximise the value delivered by all teams
- Listen to colleagues and customers and shows consideration for diversity and taps into potential
- Assume the responsibilities of the Product Owner in their absence
